



Job Announcement National Consultant

I. Background

Cambodia ratified the Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) on 15 October 1992. Cambodia as a state party has an obligation to make the initial report and the periodic report on the implementation of the CRC to the UN Child Rights Committee (UNCRC) after its ratification. In 2018, Cambodia has to develop and submit the 4th, 5th and 6th combined reports on the implementation of UNCRC.

II. Purpose of Consultancy

Develop the 4th, 5th and 6th combining reports on the implementation of CRC in Cambodia to be submitted to UNCRC in 2018.

III. Key activities

- 1- To collect the information on the key progress of the implementation of children's rights with relevant ministries from 2008-2018.
- 2- To review and analyze the key achievements, existing sectoral policies, legislations and implementations related to UNCRC and recommendations.
- 3- To develop 4th, 5th and 6th combining report on the implementation of CRC in Cambodia.
- 4- To conduct the consultative meetings and workshop with children, relevant stakeholders.
- 5- To present draft report to National Committee on Planning and Reporting and CNCC members.
- 6- To compile the data and explanatory note of all report sections, orient and explain those key information/support documents to the policy makers to defense at COM stage and UN committee.
- 7- To develop the report both in Khmer and English version.

IV. Time frame

This consultancy will take this assignment within 45 working days will start in April 1st, 2017 to May, 2018.

- A master's degree preferably in the field of social work, law, economic, public policy, human rights
- Solid knowledge on child rights, women rights and human rights, and including rights-based approach

- Solid knowledge of the Cambodian context
